



## Placement Testing for International Students

Per F-1 visa regulations, students must be fully accepted to their degree program to receive an I-20. To ensure that students are prepared for college-level courses and to determine whether students will require co-requisite support courses in their program, Pikes Peak requires placement testing prior to issuing an I-20.

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### Section 1. Placement Testing Options

- **Complete EdReady.** EdReady is a personalized, free, and self-paced learning system that is used to assess students' English and Math readiness. Pikes Peak is using EdReady as a placement option, but it can also be used as a study resource to help you with your Pikes Peak English and/or Math courses. You can also use EdReady to help you prepare for the Accuplacer exam. EdReady can be completed on-line from the comfort of your home.

- **Take the Accuplacer in-person if in the U.S.**

- **Take the Accuplacer on-line with Examiity, Accuplacer approved virtual proctor.**
  - First you must verify if you meet the [technical requirements](#). If you do, send an email to [testing.center@pikespeak.edu](mailto:testing.center@pikespeak.edu) requesting an on-line voucher to test with Examiity. Include in the email your full name, your PPSC student number, and the exam you need to take. For example: Accuplacer English, Accuplacer Math, or both. ***Fees might apply to this option.***
- **Take the Accuplacer remotely at an approved testing center in the US or abroad. Testing options might vary per country.**

your PPSC student number, and the exam you need to take. For example: Accuplacer English, Accuplacer Math, or both. **Fees might apply to this option.**

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## Section 2. How to Complete EdReady from the Comfort of your Home

1. Go to [pikespeak.edready.org](http://pikespeak.edready.org) and create an **EdReady account**.
  - Please sign up using the email you included in your PPSC application.
  - Only scores from the **PPSC EdReady platform** will be accepted for placement. You will know you are in the PPSC platform if you see the PPSC logo.
2. Enter the **Goal Key** for the course you are trying to place into (See the charts at the bottom of this page for the appropriate Goal Key).
3. Complete the diagnostic test, work through lessons, and retake topics and units to earn your desired score. A score of 90 is required for placement into college level courses. If you score 90 or higher, the Testing Center will get an automatic notification with your score report. They will process your scores and email you letting you know you are ready for college level coursework.

Students who score less than a 90 will need to take co-requisite courses. *Please note students that pursue a major requiring MAT 1340 must make a score of 90 or higher. \*\*Students needing MAT 1340 are not permitted to enroll in remedial courses\*\**

If you score less than 90, you must export your score report directly to the Testing Center. To Export your scores:

- Go to "My Account"
  - Under "Student data export" select "Download Your Data"
  - In the textbox enter: [testing.center@pikespeak.edu](mailto:testing.center@pikespeak.edu)
  - The Testing Center will email you when your scores have been processed
4. Fill out your I-20 application form if the rest of your documents are ready.
