- American Sign Language proficiency of ASL II with a grade of 'B' or better; ASL Proficiency Screening, or heritage signer.
- Completion of ENG 121, ANT 101, and COM 115. Remaining general education courses must be completed by the end of Semester 3
- Class size is limited Admission priority and consideration will be based on: date application is received, completion of all general education courses, GPA, English proficiency skills as determined by written responses in the application as well as consideration of Deaf community involvement and goals.
