## GLOSSARY OF TERMS

- **Academic program:** An instructional program leading toward a certificate or an associate's degree.
- **Academic year:** The time period containing the academic sessions held during consecutive summer, fall, and spring semesters.
- **Associate's degree:** An award that normally requires at least 2 but less than 4 years of full-time equivalent college work.
- **Census date:** Date at which enrollment data are “frozen” for reporting purposes. Typically reflects the end of the drop/add period for course registration.
- **Certificate:** A formal award certifying the satisfactory completion of a postsecondary education program.
- **Credit hour:** A unit of measure representing the equivalent of an hour (50 minutes) of instruction per week over the entire term.
- **Cohort:** A specific group of students established for tracking purposes.
- **Continuing student:** A student who was enrolled at Pikes Peak Community College the preceding academic year.
- **Degree/certificate seeking student:** A student enrolled in courses for credit and recognized by the institution as seeking a degree or certificate.
- **Duplicated headcount:** Occurs when a student is counted more than one time. For instance, a student who attends classes in summer, fall, and spring is counted three times.
- **Fall-to-Fall All Student Retention:** Tracks the percentage of all enrolled students, regardless of academic program or student population type, who continue their enrollment into the following fall term. Retention is determined by either re-enrollment in the next fall or completion of a credential by the end of the following fall term.
- **Fall-to-Fall Cohort Retention:** The percentage of first-time, full-time, degree-seeking students who re-enroll the following fall term, including students who began in the summer preceding the fall term. Students are counted as retained if they re-enroll in the following fall or complete a credential by the end of that summer. This calculation follows CDHE and IPEDS methods.

- **First-time student:** A student attending any institution of postsecondary education for the first time. Includes students enrolled in the fall term who enrolled for the first time in the prior summer term.
- **Fiscal year:** A twelve-month period running from July 1st through the following June 30th.
- **Full-time student:** A student who takes at least 12 credit hours in a specific semester.
- **Full-time equivalent (FTE):** A budgetary term derived from the total number of student credit hours. Annualized FTE is calculated by dividing total credit hours by 30.
- **Graduation rate 150%:** Percentage of cohort students (first-time, full-time, degree/certificate seeking) that have graduated from the institution within 150 Percentage of normal time to degree completion, or three years.
- **Graduation rate 200%:** Percentage of cohort students (first-time, full-time, degree/certificate seeking) that have graduated from the institution within 200 Percentage of normal time to degree completion, or four years.
- **Headcount:** The number of students enrolled in one or more courses, at one or more locations. This number may be duplicated (see Duplicated headcount) or unduplicated (see Unduplicated headcount).
- **Part-time student:** A student enrolled for less than 12 semester credit hours in a term.
- **Priority campus:** A campus location where students take the majority of their credit hours.
- **Readmit student:** A student who formerly attended Pikes Peak Community College and is returning after being absent for three terms.
- **Transfer student:** Student entry type. A student entering an institution for the first time but known to have previously attended a postsecondary institution at the same level (e.g., undergraduate, graduate). The student may transfer with or without credit.
- **Transfer out rate:** Percentage of cohort students (first-time, full-time, degree/certificate seeking) that have not graduated from the institution but have been identified as transfer students through the National Student Clearinghouse within three years.
- **Transfer rate:** Percentage of all students enrolled in a given academic year that transfer to other institutions of higher education as reported through the National Student Clearinghouse.
- **Transfer upon graduation:** Percentage of cohort students (first-time, full-time, degree/certificate seeking) that have graduated from the institution within three years and then transferred to other

institutions of higher education (within four years of starting at PPCC) as identified through the National Student Clearinghouse.

- **Unduplicated headcount:** In a given period of time, the total count of students enrolled in for-credit courses with each student being counted only once regardless of when the student enrolled.
