

Estimated Tuition for ESL Classes 2020-2021

Payment or payment arrangements should be made with the Cashier (Room A110) soon after registration. Students who have not paid, have not made payment arrangements, or have not applied for Financial Aid may be dropped from classes at the beginning of the semester. Please call the Cashier at (719) 502-2444 with any questions.

Resident Students are students with resident alien cards, refugee or asylee status, U.S. citizens **AND** who have lived in Colorado for at least one year. (Colorado Driver's License or Colorado State I.D. card is usually used as proof of Colorado residence.) In addition, active military/spouses are usually eligible for resident tuition and do not have the one year residence requirement. Check with Enrollment Services (Room A110) for more details.

Non-Resident Students are students with business, visitor and other visas **AND** other students who have not lived in Colorado for at least one year.
