A maximum of nine (9) credits may be articulated without taking a course at PPSC. To transcribe additional articulated credits, at least one PPSC course must be taken (online, in-seat, hybrid). Students must articulate courses within three years of high school course completion. High schools confirm courses annually and must resubmit for reconsideration after three years.
