### REMOTE LEARNING WILL CONTINUE THROUGH SPRING

In light of Gov. Polis' Safer at Home guidelines, PPCC will continue to provide the vast majority of our classes remotely through the rest of the semester.

But some in-person Career and Technical Education classes and some student services will be available on Monday, May 4.

Know that the college remains dedicated to two foundational values: helping you fulfill your educational goals while also keeping you as safe as humanly possible.

Not only has the college's facilities staff cleaned the campuses to the highest hygienic levels, they've also installed plexiglass shields where necessary to protect students and staff.

Rampart Range Campus/CHES Building and the Centennial Campus will open on May 4. The Downtown Studio Campus/Studio West will remain closed until inface instruction returns more widely. Students may use the Learning Commons, the PPCC Bookstore, and the Computer Labs.

We will operate our campuses with the health-officials' recommended protocols: everyone must wear masks (they will be provided if needed) and social distancing will be strictly enforced. Anyone who is sick must stay home.
