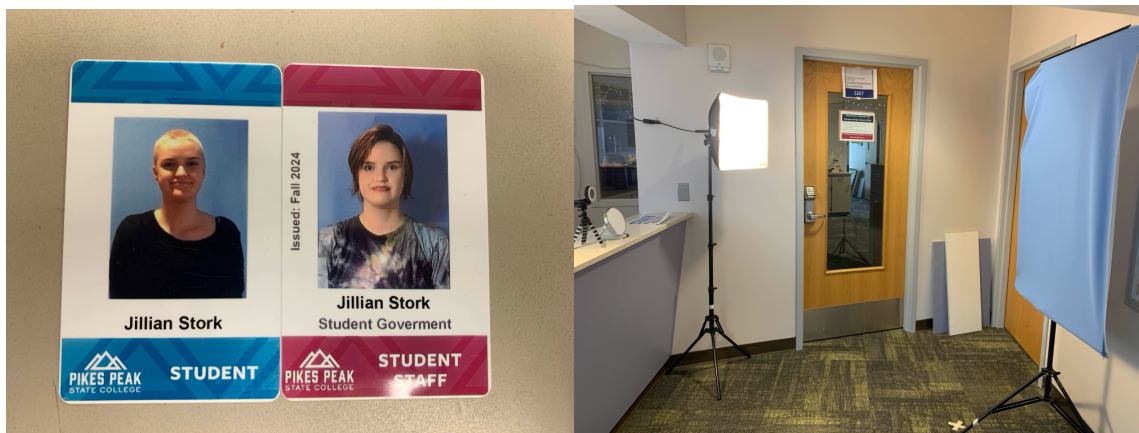

# Rampart Student Life Area

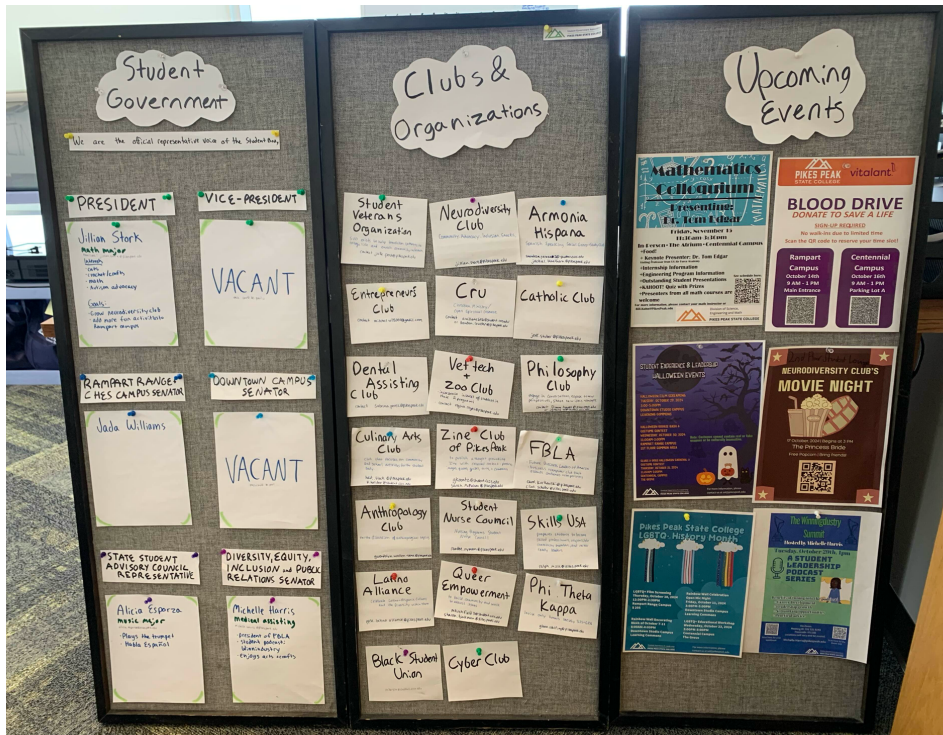
Rampart Range campus lacked a more laid back student center
